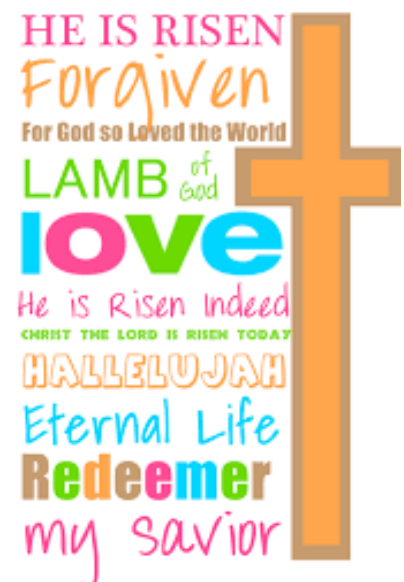
Recreation Notes—Sherri Davis
