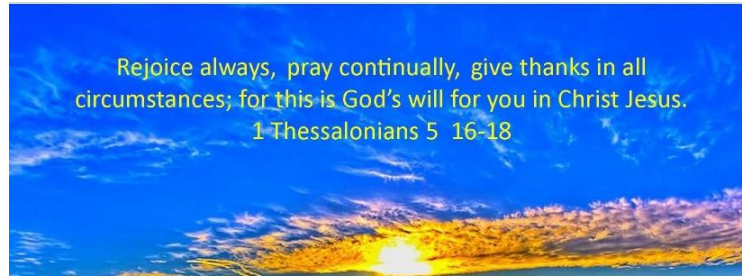
## Outdoor Visits

Dear Lord,

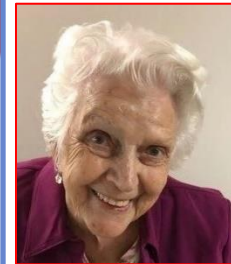

## What Do You Love About Canada?

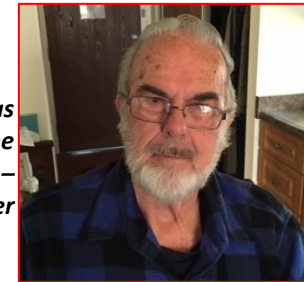

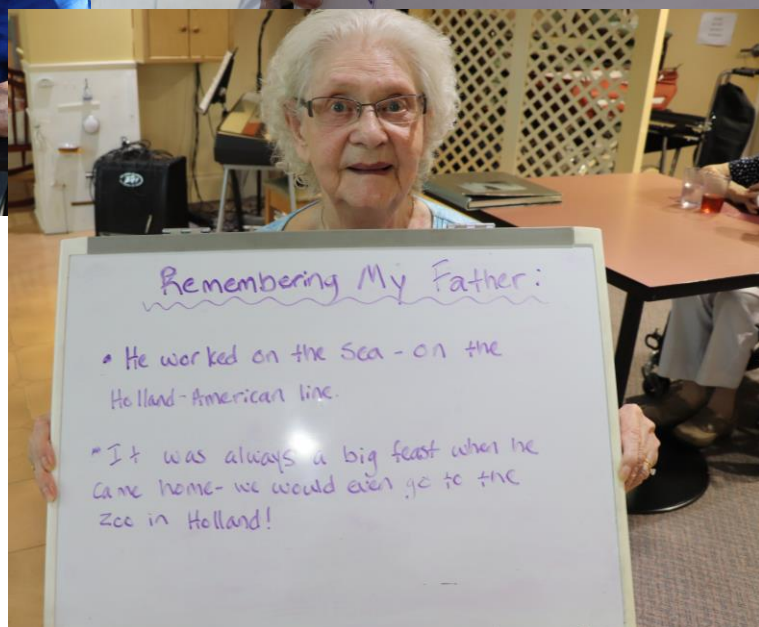
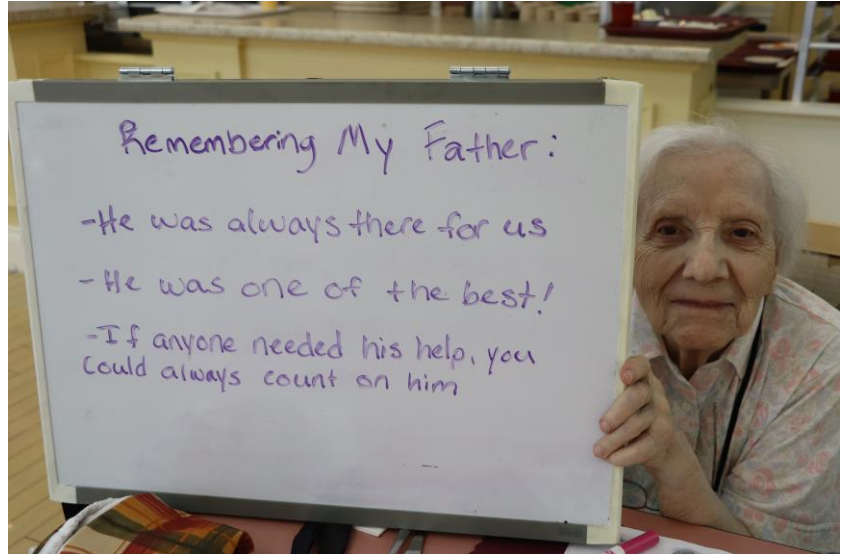
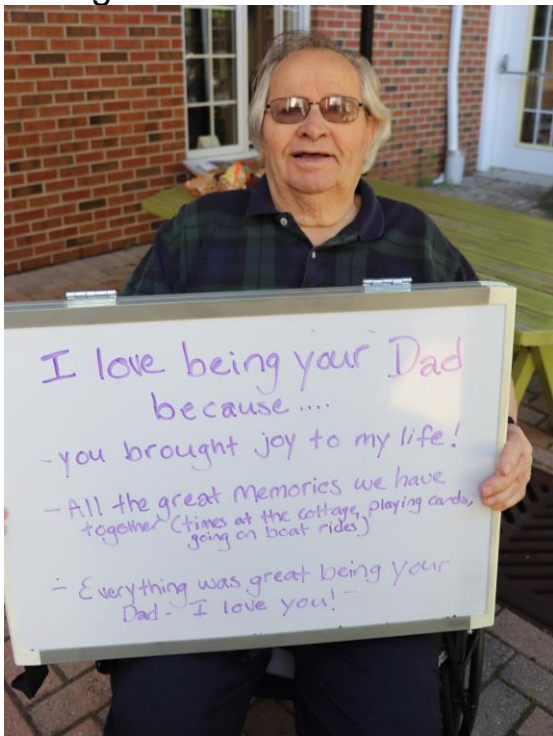


## Leah Turned 101!

# Father's Day! We celebrated Father's Day with Donuts and reminiscing about being a Dad or about our Dads!

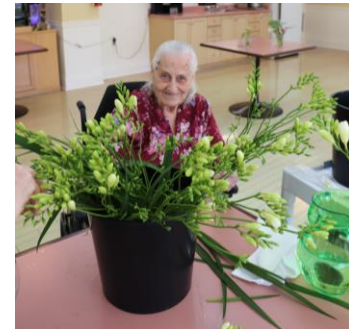


## Outdoor Bubbles!
