Facts about the Olympics in Tokyo

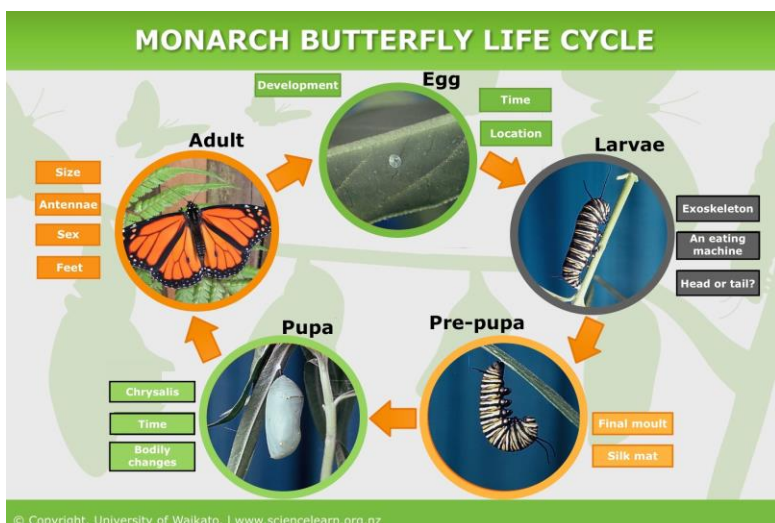
- Four new Olympic sports have made their debut at the Tokyo 2020 Games: karate, skateboarding, sport climbing and surfing.
- Items such as podiums, uniforms and medals are all made from recycled materials. Even the beds at the Olympic Village are made from cardboard, which will be recycled after the Games.
- People in Japan were asked to donate their disused electronics such as mobile phones to contribute to the production of the Olympics and Paralympics medals.
- The Olympic and Paralympic mascots were chosen by 16,769 elementary school children who voted on their favorite designs. The Olympic mascot, known as Miraitowa, is designed with the classic Japanese indigo blue. The Paralympic mascot, on the other hand, is known as Someity, which features the same pink as Japan's famous cherry blossoms.

Caterpillars to Butterflies

Residents and staff have been watching and enjoying the monarch butterfly metamorphosis from egg to butterfly.



The entire egg-to-butterfly process, called metamorphosis, takes about a month. Once out of the pupa, the damp butterfly inflates its wings with blood stored in its abdomen. It must wait for its wings to dry before it flies away. So far, we have released 2 butterflies into the courtyard, with around 5 more to add!
