June Recap!

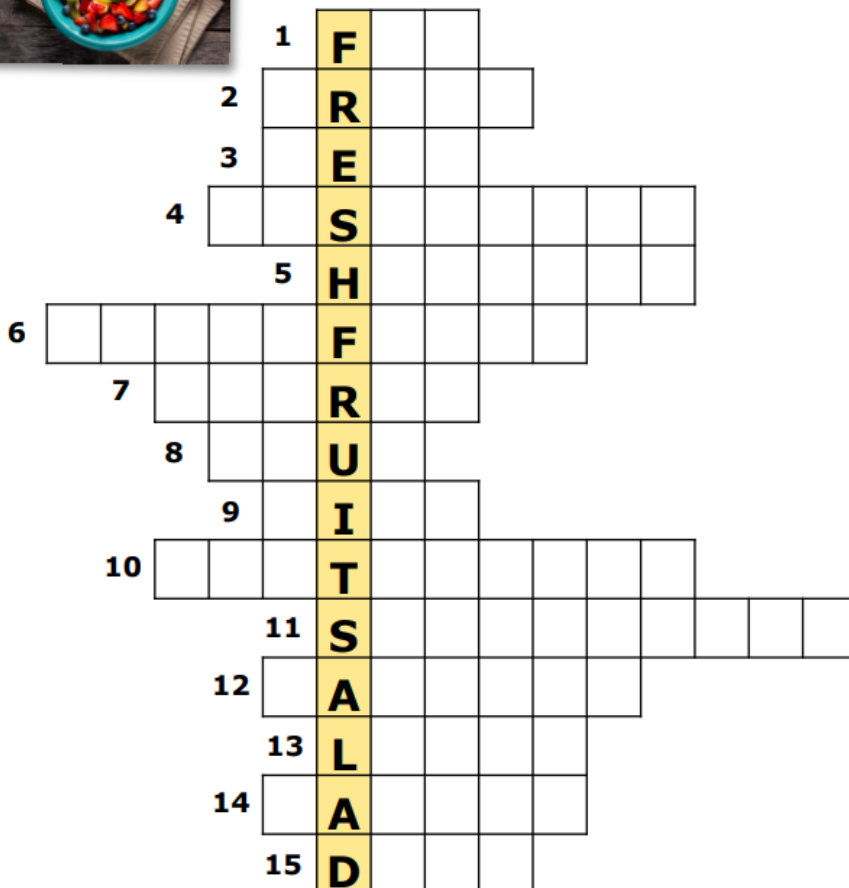
