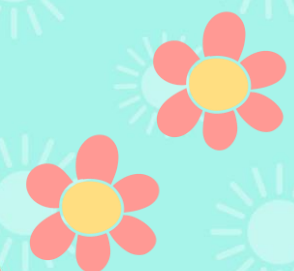

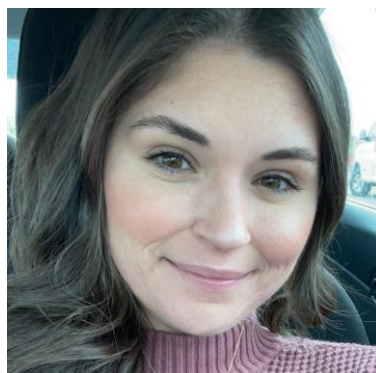
## Meet Marta Waszak - Assistant Director of Care

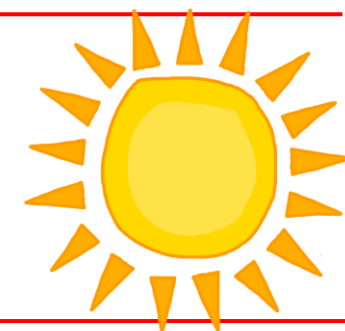

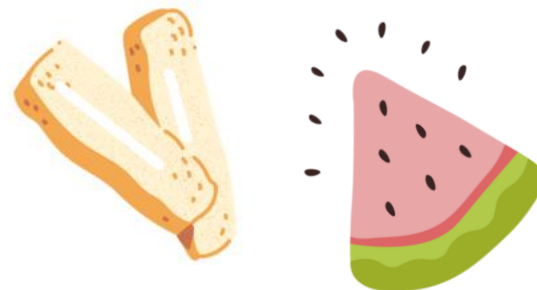


### Ice Cream Sundaes
