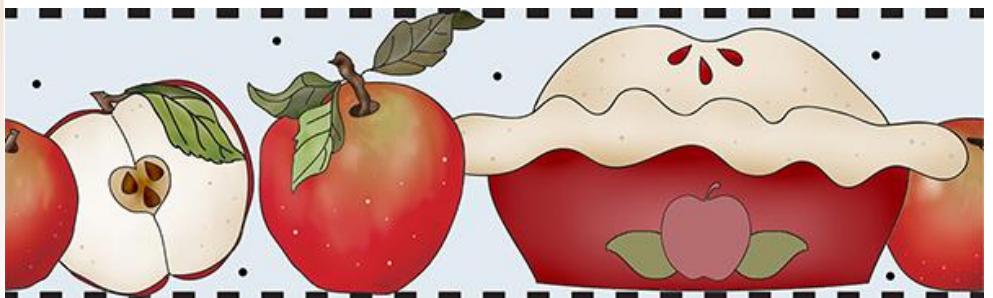

Each fall, my mother would put the following words of John Wesley on a bulletin board display in her elementary school classroom. She also hung a framed picture of the words on the wall of our living room. Wesley penned, “Do all the good you can, by all the means you can, in all the ways you can, in all the places you can, at all the times you can, to all the people you can, as long as ever you can.” Those words struck a deep chord with my mother, and they continue to speak to my heart today.
